

An endoscopic short-term colonic lavage with picosulfate-mannitol was performed in 20 patients with severe fulminant ulcerative colitis. This procedure is performed with a flexible endoscope and the solution is introduced in the colon through the biopsy channel and then drained back into the intestine. The solution enters the sigmoid colon in a single pass. The procedure is repeated after a time interval of 15 min. In 14 out of 20 patients, a complete colonic and rectal healing was observed after the first lavage. In six patients, the procedure failed and had to be repeated. A complete rectal healing was observed in three patients. We conclude that this short-term colonic lavage is a feasible therapeutic approach to treat fulminant ulcerative colitis, although further studies in a larger group of patients are needed.
